Booking and Fee Payment Terms

Payment of fees

All fees must be paid in advance by the first day of attendance on our Playscheme. Fees may be paid in cash, by cheque or by standing order. Standing order forms can be obtained on request from the managers. **Please make cheques payable to Bright Beginnings.**

If a child is absent from the Playscheme for any reason, full fees must still be paid. Full fees are payable for both full and part time places which have been booked. We regret that these sessions cannot be made up at a later date and are non refundable.

All fees must be paid in advance

The Proprietors may cancel a child's playscheme place booking with immediate effect and refuse entry to the playscheme if fees are not paid promptly as required.

Fees not paid promptly and on time will incur a £5 charge for every week of the late payment. If returned cheques incur a bank charge, this will be passed onto the relevant parent.

Sickness

If your child is ill at any time, where possible please notify a member of staff. If a child is taken ill during a session all efforts will be made to contact you or another contact from your completed Registration form.

If your child shows any signs of infectious disease or virus e.g. (diarrhoea and sickness) it is necessary to contact the Playscheme as soon as possible. Any child with an infectious disease should be collected to prevent the spread of infection throughout the Playscheme.

General

Please inform staff in advance if anyone other than the notified person will be collecting your child from the playscheme. Bright Beginnings will NOT allow you child to leave with anyone who is unfamiliar with to us. Please label all coats and please make sure that children are dressed accordingly, Bright Beginnings will not accept responsibility for any loss or damage to valuables.

Children must be collected promptly at the end of sessions. If they are not it means staff have to remain on hand to look after the children and have to be paid for doing so. Accordingly if children are not collected on time a fee of £5.00 for every fifteen minutes late will be payable.

The Playscheme reserves the right to change the fee scales and the proprietor will endeavour to give one month's written notice.

All outstanding fee invoices will be enforced and collected if necessary through the services of a debt collection company.

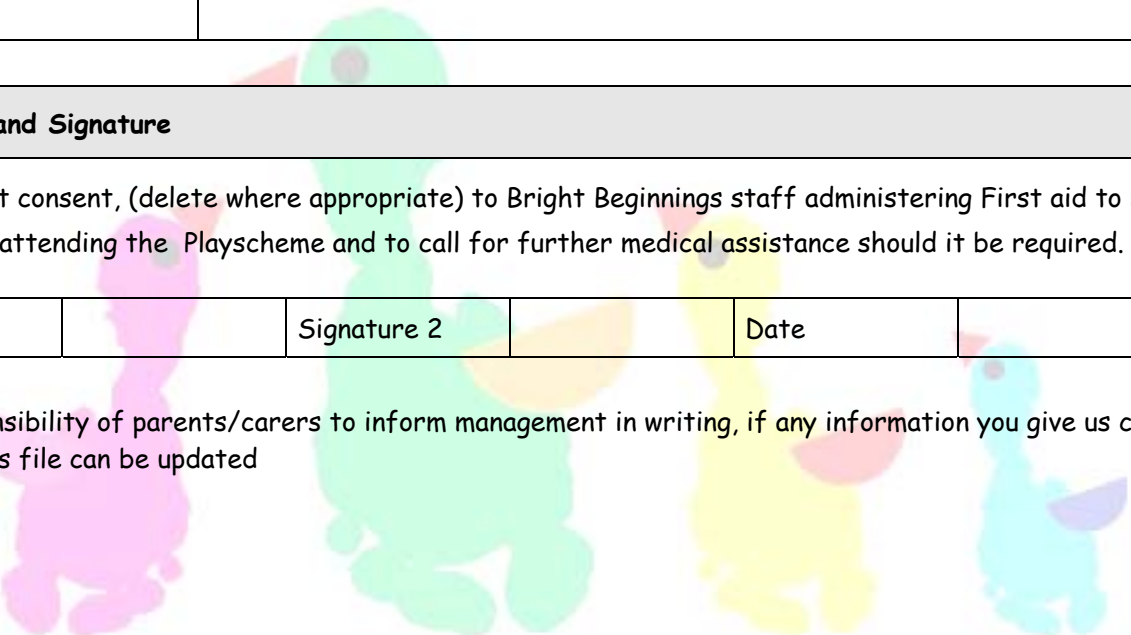

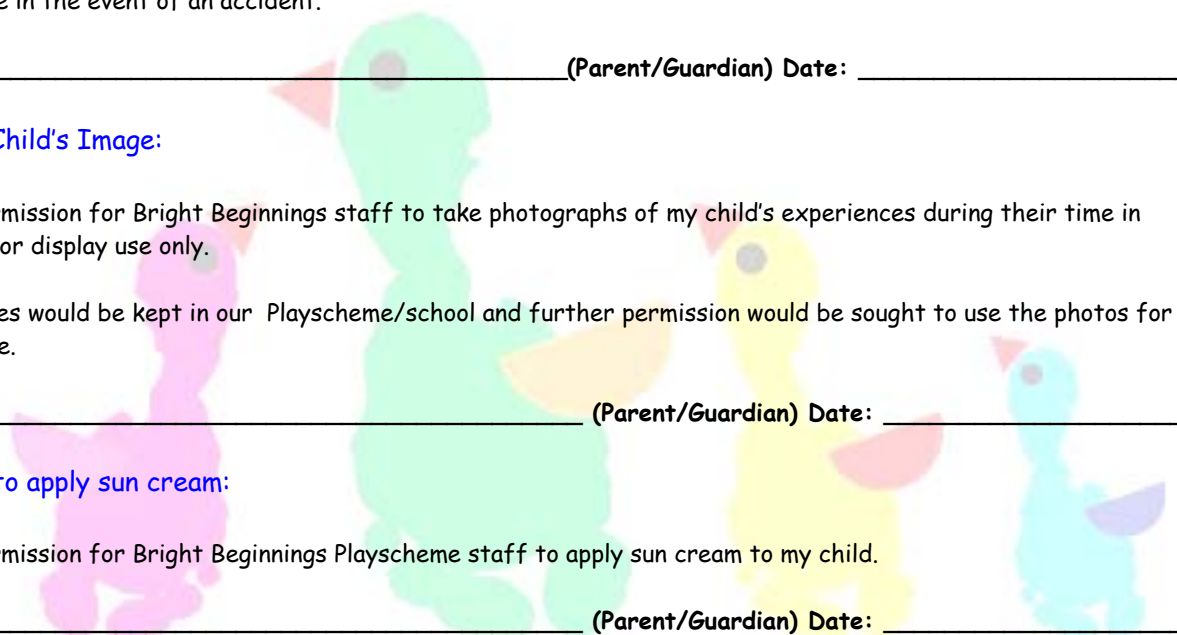
